
Neo 5G: It was so much fun, especially no homework! I really enjoyed the performance poetry, but I think the best bit was that we all played and worked together.'


Nicholas 5G: 'On Monday we didn't know what to expect and felt a little sad that we weren't going on camp. But, it was a good week and we had lots of fun.'
